Granville East Primary School Library Needs Your Help !

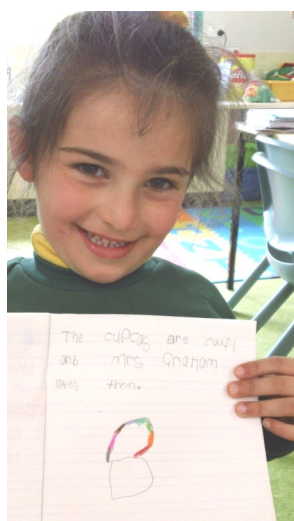
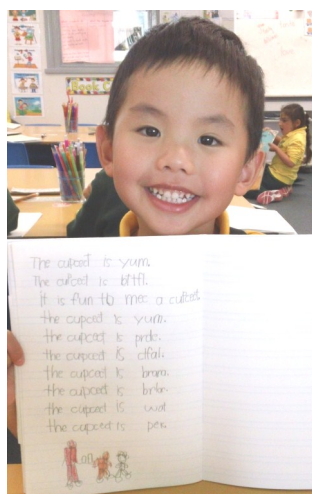
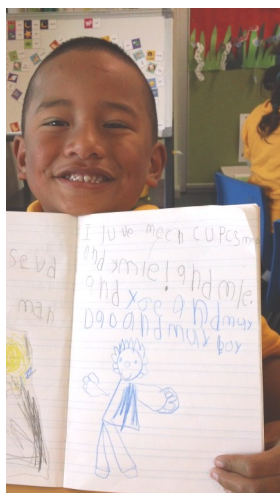
