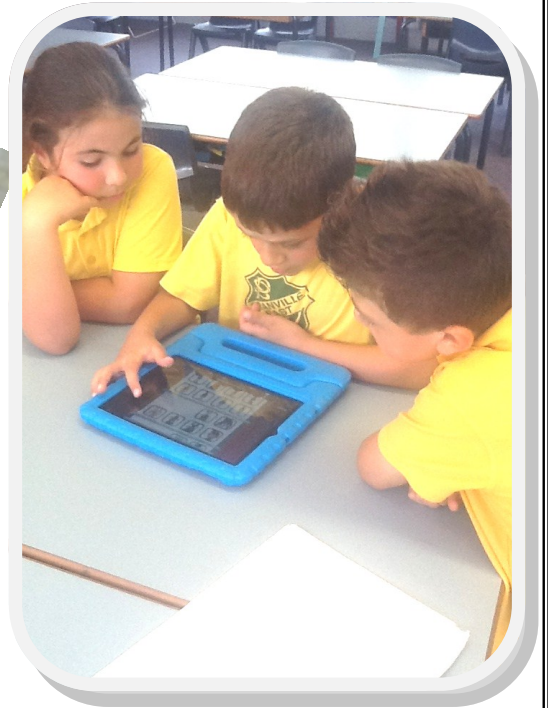
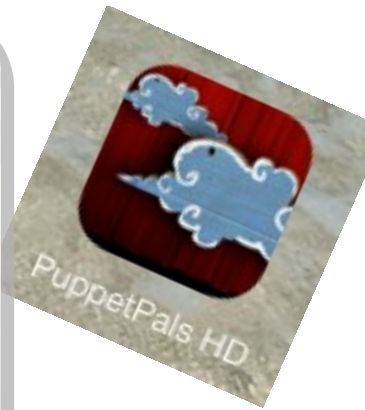


Script Writers in 1/2N.

1/2N have been busy writing humorous and adventurous stories! Students planned and edited their scripts before creating their animations using the Puppet Pals app on the iPad.



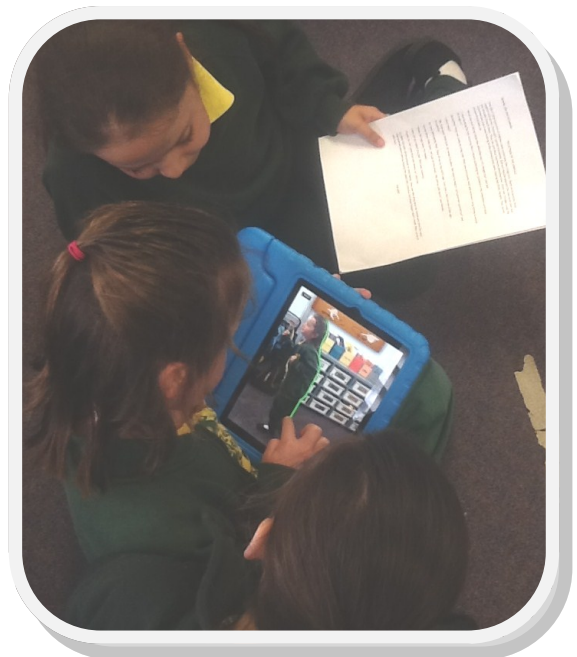
