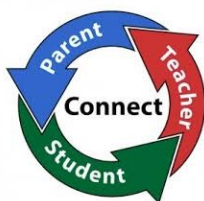
### Planning for 2017

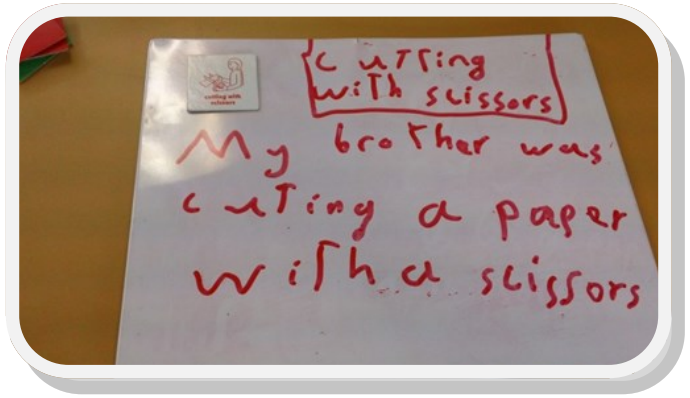
