Learning is everywhere!

Yesterday's Mini-Fete was a huge success! It prompted Mrs Tainsh and Mrs Costantini to write about it on our K-2 teachers' Blog. Here is an excerpt of what they wrote:

During Mini Fete we couldn't help but **notice the learning** that was happening all around us!

There were the more obvious examples of learning including **reading** signs and advertisements, **adding** and **subtracting** money and **keeping score** in the games.

The more subtle included

- **using adjectives** to describe and guess 'What was in the box?'
- **deciding** where the best place to set up the slip and slide was so that best slide could be achieved by using the greatest **incline** and
- having **opportunities to purchase** items from a real fete stall and **negotiating decisions** with stall holders.

We can **capitalise** on students excitement around Mini Fete and **continue** the learning by making links to real world experiences.

For example—here are some ways we can stimulate students thinking and recognise the learning in an everyday situation!

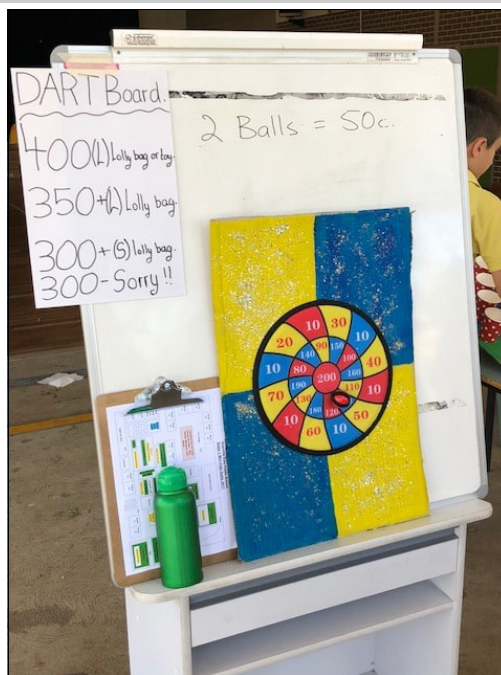


One whole pizza has 8 slices.

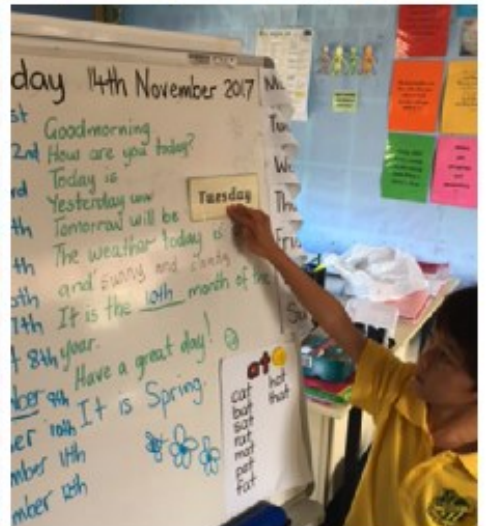

Stage 1: New Arrival Program

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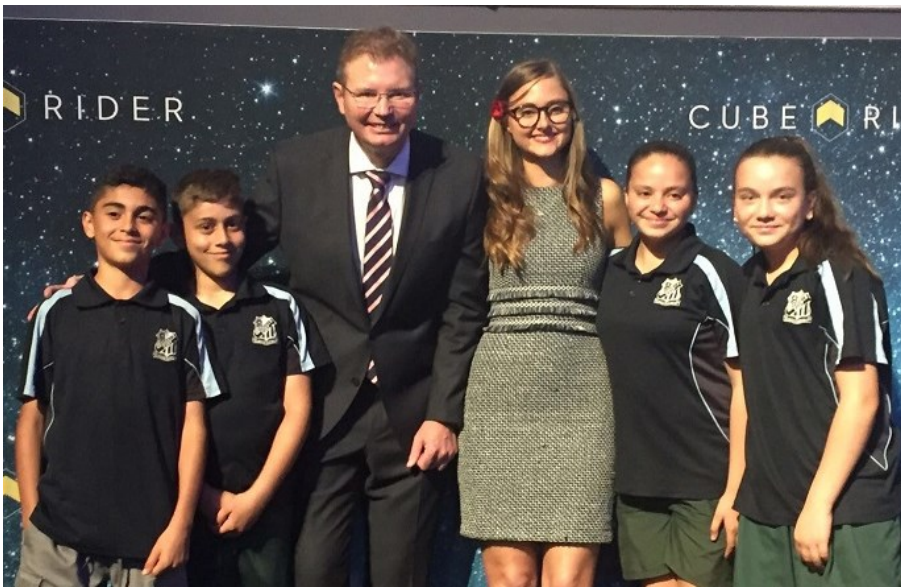
Students working together and having fun practising their English.



2017 SPACE SHOWCASE EVENT

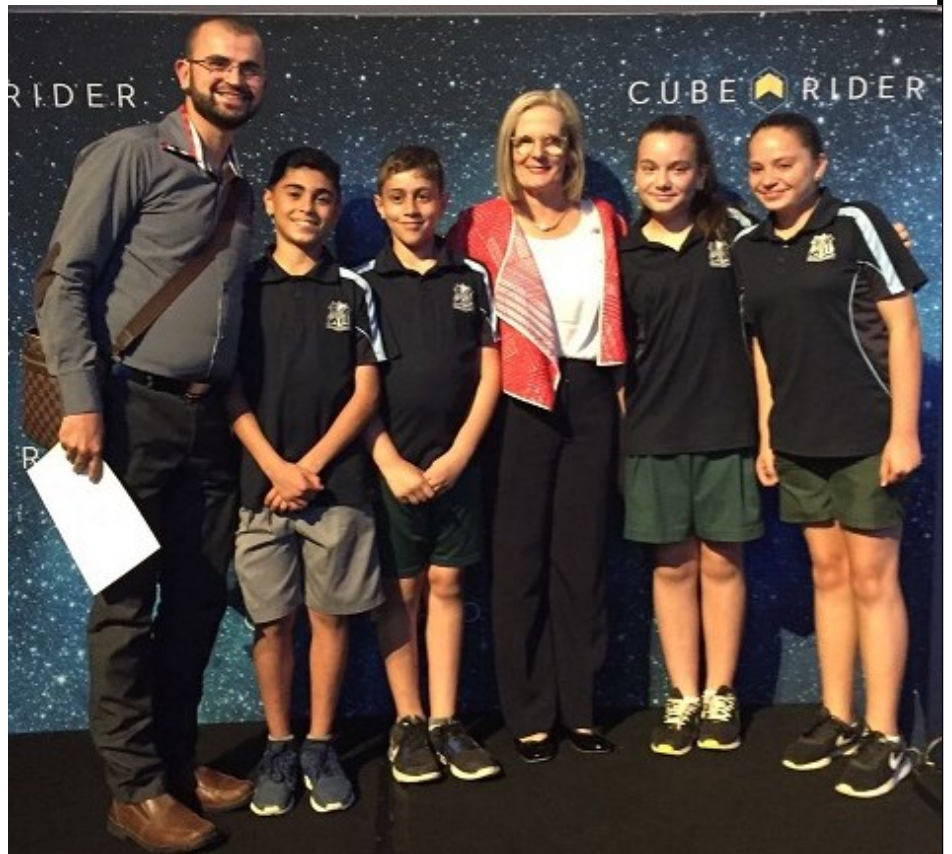
Last Friday, Mr Zereka took 4 students (and their parents) to the Powerhouse Museum.

Peacock Gallery & Auburn Art Studio

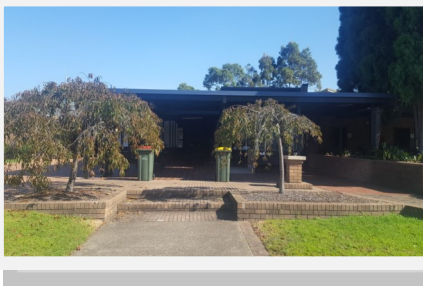


Auburn Botanic Gardens

Situated directly opposite the main entrance to auburn Botanic Gardens on Chiswick Road.

Approximately five minutes drive from GEPS; a 30 minute walk; 20 minute walk from nearest bus stop.



What's on Offer

Two gallery spaces, arts and crafts studio, outdoor workshop area and a regular program of exhibitions and activities, small gallery, picnic area and toilets.

Open Tuesday to Sunday

Peacock Gallery

There are two exhibition areas which present diverse exhibitions. Works include photography, Indonesian & Aboriginal art.

Art Studio

Small studio area available for Art and Craft. Open to the public by appointment only.



Outstanding Features

A sculptural artwork "Sunshine and Crows" marks the entrance to the gallery and grounds.

Created by Aboriginal artists and pays homage to the **Darug** people who first occupied this area. Peacocks wander freely on the grounds.



The Auburn Aviary

Opposite the gallery is the Auburn Aviary, a small area with five bird enclosures. There are birds of many species, native and non native.
