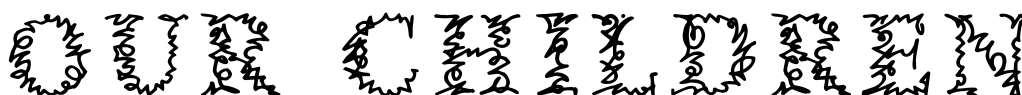

We've developed a clear framework on a school website that is constantly referred to and drives professional learning. It's an important tool to help embed this practice in every-day teaching and learning at Granville East.

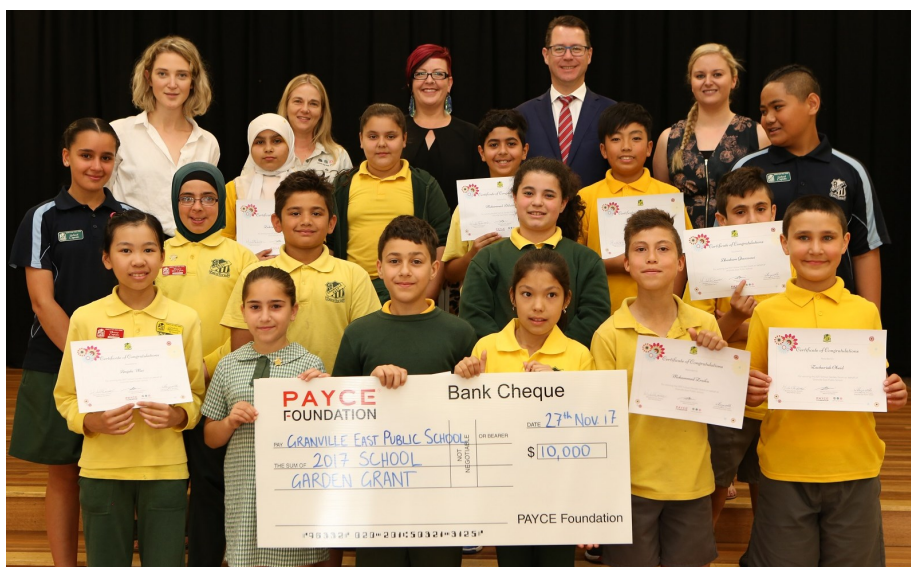
We want **every student to get powerful learning**—in *every space* and *every place*!

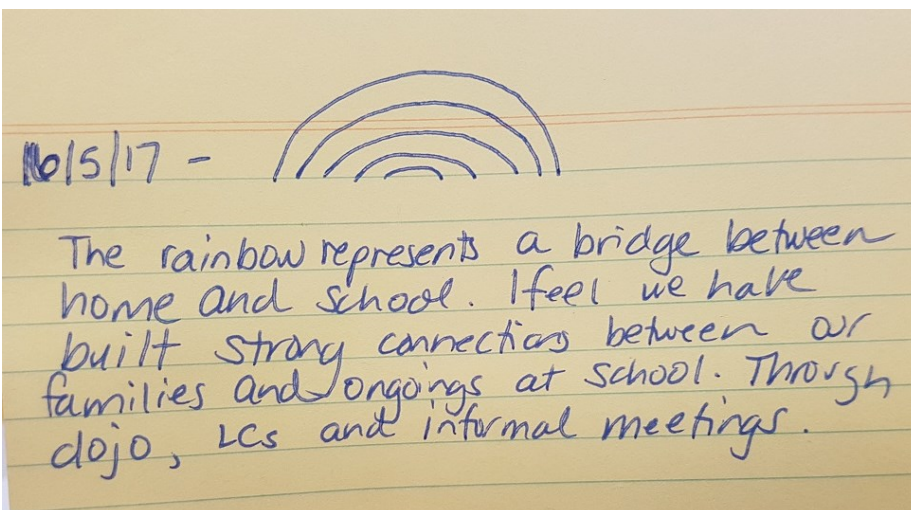


## Thank You to our Community Helpers

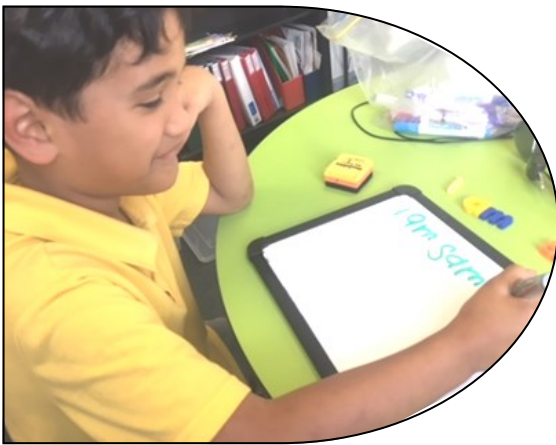

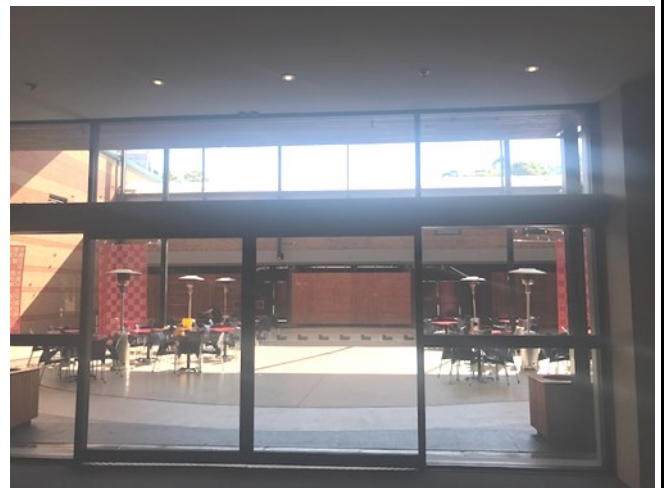
# THE RIVERSIDE THEATRE
