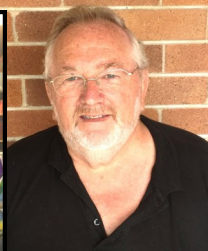

If you are awarded 10 GEPStars (for showing respect, pride or courage) you can earn a Galaxy merit!



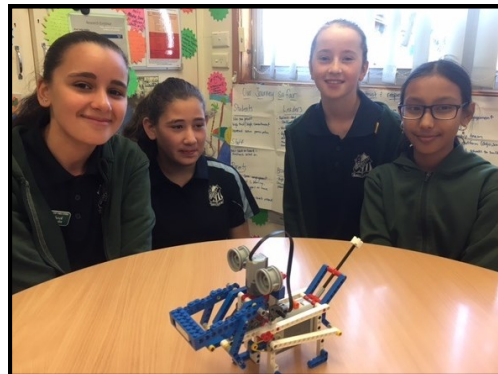
The first 3 students at GEPS to have earned this wonderful award are:
