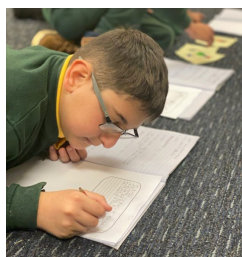
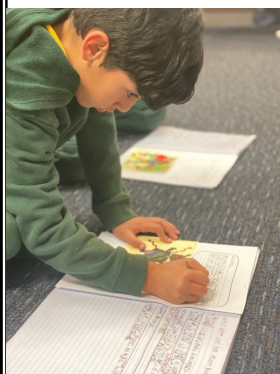
Happy SASS Week!

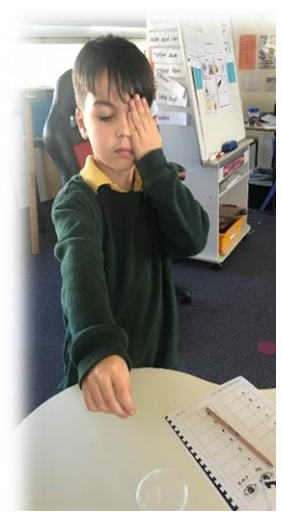
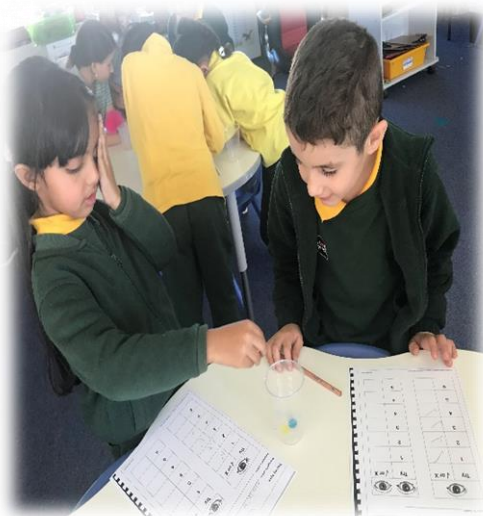


STEM in TERM 3

STEM = Science, Tech, Engineering & Maths. This term for JELO students across all stages have been focusing on STEM - especially ***Physical and Earth Sciences***.

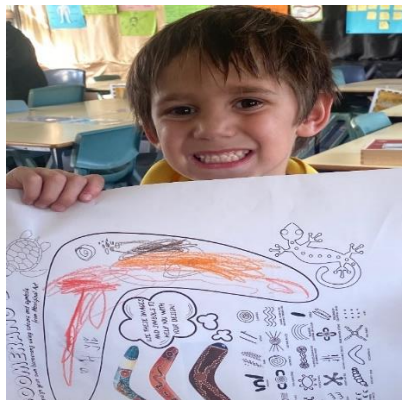
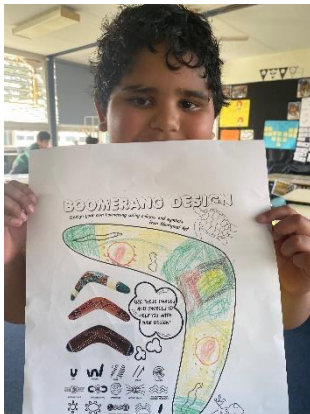
Students have been introduced to different topics including look-listen, heating up and light shows.

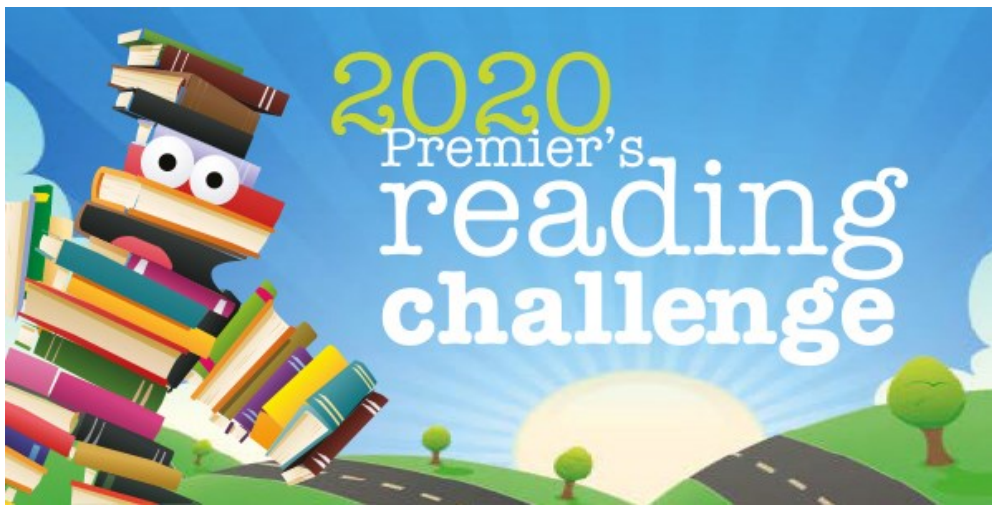

MATHS CORNER

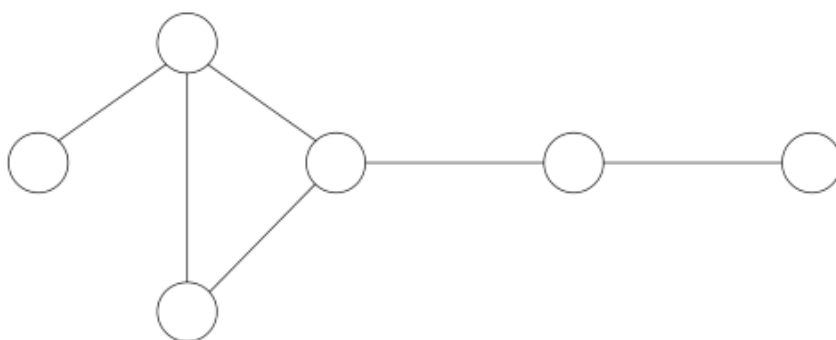

We can represent a group of friends by drawing a graph. Each circle represents a person. An edge joins two circles if and only if those two people are friends. Here is a graph showing a group of friends.

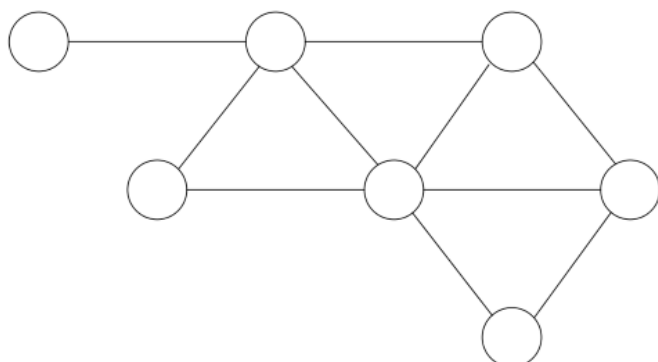
Can you work out who's who using the clues below?
